

Monroe Middle School - NJHS Selection Process

An informational meeting for the selection process into NJHS will take place in February or March of each school year and application packets will be distributed. Students who submit all required application materials, prior to the required deadline, and meet the selection criteria will be able to participate in NJHS prior to the induction.

Selection shall consist of the following criteria:

1. Admissible G.P.A. 3.4
2. Successful completion of the Student Information Form
3. Typed application essay (attached to Student Information Form)
4. Two letters of recommendation--one from an educator and one from a non-educator (attached to Student Information Form)
5. Discipline: student has NOT received in-house or out of school suspensions
6. ALL above required application materials are turned in prior to the deadline

To maintain membership after selection:

1. Maintain minimum GPA (3.4)
2. Maintain a positive behavioral record, no in-house or out of school suspensions
3. Must perform four (4) hours of community service per semester
4. 80% attendance rate of National Junior Honor Society meetings, gatherings, etc.

Students will need teachers to fill out recommendations/evaluation forms. The application packets will have a due date on them and must be turned in on time to be considered for selection. The packets must be filled out neatly, completely and correctly. Selection is an honor. When the packets are received, the selection committee will review them for selection.

Students selected to be a part of NJHS will participate in an induction ceremony in the Spring. The date will be announced after the selection process.
