Holly Scherer is the new Executive Director of Human Resources at Monroe Public Schools (7-29). The MPS Board voted to renew the district's MHSAA membership (7-29 online). MPS school board candidates for the November 3rd election include **Cindy Flynn**, **Amanda Hawes**, **Pansy Heath**, **Thomas Heck**, **Jesse Mayo**, **Darla Myers**, **Laura Petee**, and **Mary Renwick** (7-24). The first day of the 2026-2027 school year in MPS will be August 31 (7-27). Michigan's Public Health Code requires hearing and vision screenings for children entering kindergarten or preschool (7-27). The Monroe County Fair Parade, which includes local school marching bands, begins at 1 p.m. on Sunday, August 2nd (7-29). Obituaries were published for **Michael Duchenne**, 29, a 2014 Monroe High School graduate (7-24); **Joyce Lewis**, 92, who attended MHS (7-26); **Rose Krueger**, 80, a 1963 MHS graduate (7-29); and **Raymond Noble**, 91, who attended MPS (7-29).

Sports Highlights

Monroe County was victorious in the All-Star game vs. Lenawee County. MHS graduate **Olivia McMahon** gave up two hits and struck out six over five innings of pitching. MHS graduate **Aly Lewis** hit a home run (7-24). **Jessica Irwin**, an Airport coach who graduated from Monroe High School, was named Monroe County Region Softball Coach of the Year by the Monroe News sports staff. All-Region players in Monroe County include MHS players **Sierra Daniels**, **Aly Lewis**, and **Delaynee Miller** (7-26). **Jennah Cadle**, a 2026 MHS graduate, was the runner-up in the La-Z-Boy Junior Open girls division with a 91-88-179. **Gracie Gottschalk** finished 98-82-180. Monroe boys **Solomon Schramm** hit 151 and **Easton Compau** 160 (7-26). Former athletes of the year from MHS include **Alana Aulph**, 2024; **Abby McCollum**, 2010; **Krissy Montague**, 1998; and **Meghan Peregord**, 1997.

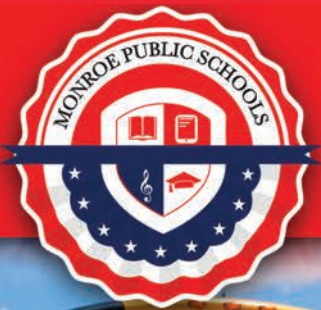

We will have MCISD staff available to complete your child's application.

TO COMPLETE YOUR CHILD'S APPLICATION, YOU WILL NEED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- ✓ Proof of Income (only 1 needed)
 - 2025 W-2s
 - Income Tax Return
 - SSI, TANF, SNAP
 - 4 weeks of pay stubs
- ✓ Foster Care documentation (if applicable)
- ✓ Child's Birth Certificate
- ✓ Immunization Record (if available)
- ✓ Parent/Caregiver ID (required)
- ✓ Proof of Residency (only 1 required) (drivers license, bill, rent lease, etc.)

*SB 133 allows children turning 4 between Sept. 2, 2026 – Dec. 1, 2026 to submit a waiver application. Space is limited based on availability and location. Enrollment may be considered after August 1, 2026.

Vaccines Required for School Entry in Michigan

Whenever children are in group settings, there is a chance for disease to spread. Parents must follow state vaccine laws in order for their children to attend school. These laws are the minimum standard for preventing disease outbreaks in group settings. The best way to protect children from serious diseases is to follow the [Immunization Recommendations for Michigan](#). When following the recommended schedule children are fully protected and any school vaccination requirements are met.



	All kindergartners and 4–6-year-old transfer students	All 7th graders and 7–18-year-old transfer students
Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTP, DTaP, Tdap) ¹	4 doses DTP or DTaP 1 dose must be at or after 4 years of age.	4 doses diphtheria and tetanus or 3 doses if 1st dose given on or after 1 year of age. 1 dose Tdap at 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade or higher.
Polio ¹	4 doses or 3 doses if dose 3 was given on or after 4 years of age.	
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) ^{1,2}	2 doses at or after 12 months of age.	
Hepatitis B ^{1,2}	3 doses.	
Meningococcal Conjugate (MenACWY) ¹	None.	1 dose at 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade or higher.
Varicella (Chickenpox) ^{1,2}	2 doses at or after 12 months of age or current lab immunity or history of varicella disease.	

¹Vaccines should be given at certain ages and at certain times (follow the [Immunization Recommendations for Michigan](#) for the recommended number of doses, correct spacing, and ages); this chart is based on Michigan school immunization requirements. We strongly encourage parents and providers to follow the AAP recommended schedule because school requirements are the minimum for protection. Follow this chart when assessing immunization status for school immunization requirements.

²If the child has not received these vaccines, documented immunity or an exemption is required. During disease outbreaks, incompletely vaccinated children may be excluded from school. Parents and guardians choosing to decline vaccines must obtain a certified non-medical exemption from a local health department. Read more about exemptions at [Michigan.gov/Immunize](#).
