How to Register Your Student Athlete on Snap!

Step 1: Go to the Registration Website

Click this link: [Monroe Public Schools Registration](#)

Or visit this link: manage.snap.app/register/monroetrojans

Step 2: Create an Account

If you are a new user, you'll need to make an account.

Click the blue "Create Account" link above the login box.

Enter your information: first name, last name, role, email, phone number, and password.

Click the blue "Create Account" button at the bottom.

Step 3: Begin Registration

Click the blue "Begin Registration" button on the right.

Choose the sport or activity you want to sign up for.

Fill out your child's information in the Add New Participant form.

Answer all the questions (like T-shirt size, concussion form, college interest, etc.).

When you're done, you'll see a "Submit Registration" button. You must click this button to finish!

Once you submit, you'll get a confirmation email.

If you don't click submit, your child will not be registered.

Uploading Your Child's Physical Form

Your child cannot play without a valid physical on file.

A valid physical:

- Has a doctor's signature
- Includes insurance information
- Includes the front and the back pages

Snap only allows you to upload *one* file (PDF, JPG, or PNG).

You'll need to combine both pages into one file before uploading.

We ask that you upload the physical form in Snap if possible. However, you may bring a paper copy to the HS Athletic Office (Room A121). If you have any questions or need help with registration, please contact the email lake@monroe.k12.mi.us

Switching to a New Sport

If your child is already registered on Snap for a sport but wants to play in a different season, follow these steps:

1. Log in to your Snap account.
2. On the home screen, find your child's name listed under Participants and click it.
3. Click the blue "Begin Registration" button.
4. Choose the new sport your child wants to play.
5. Review and update any information if needed, such as T-shirt size, medical forms, or contact information.
6. If your child already has a valid physical on file from a previous season, you don't need to upload it again.
7. Make sure all boxes are checked (like the concussion acknowledgment).
8. When everything is complete, click "Submit Registration" to finish.

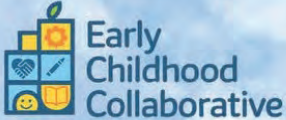

TO COMPLETE YOUR CHILD'S APPLICATION, YOU WILL NEED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- ✓ Proof of Income (only 1 needed)
 - 2025 W-2s
 - Income Tax Return
 - SSI, TANF, SNAP
 - 4 weeks of pay stubs
- ✓ Foster Care documentation (if applicable)
- ✓ Child's Birth Certificate
- ✓ Immunization Record (if available)
- ✓ Parent/Caregiver ID (required)
- ✓ Proof of Residency (only 1 required) (drivers license, bill, rent lease, etc.)

*SB 133 allows children turning 4 between Sept. 2, 2026 – Dec. 1, 2026 to submit a waiver application. Space is limited based on availability and location. Enrollment may be considered after August 1, 2026.

Vaccines Required for School Entry in Michigan

Whenever children are in group settings, there is a chance for disease to spread. Parents must follow state vaccine laws in order for their children to attend school. These laws are the minimum standard for preventing disease outbreaks in group settings. The best way to protect children from serious diseases is to follow the [Immunization Recommendations for Michigan](#). When following the recommended schedule children are fully protected and any school vaccination requirements are met.



	All kindergartners and 4–6-year-old transfer students	All 7th graders and 7–18-year-old transfer students
Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTP, DTaP, Tdap) ¹	4 doses DTP or DTaP 1 dose must be at or after 4 years of age.	4 doses diphtheria and tetanus or 3 doses if 1st dose given on or after 1 year of age. 1 dose Tdap at 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade or higher.
Polio ¹	4 doses or 3 doses if dose 3 was given on or after 4 years of age.	
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) ^{1,2}	2 doses at or after 12 months of age.	
Hepatitis B ^{1,2}	3 doses.	
Meningococcal Conjugate (MenACWY) ¹	None.	1 dose at 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade or higher.
Varicella (Chickenpox) ^{1,2}	2 doses at or after 12 months of age or current lab immunity or history of varicella disease.	

¹Vaccines should be given at certain ages and at certain times (follow the [Immunization Recommendations for Michigan](#) for the recommended number of doses, correct spacing, and ages); this chart is based on Michigan school immunization requirements. We strongly encourage parents and providers to follow the AAP recommended schedule because school requirements are the minimum for protection. Follow this chart when assessing immunization status for school immunization requirements.

²If the child has not received these vaccines, documented immunity or an exemption is required. During disease outbreaks, incompletely vaccinated children may be excluded from school. Parents and guardians choosing to decline vaccines must obtain a certified non-medical exemption from a local health department. Read more about exemptions at [Michigan.gov/Immunize](#).
