## Lincoln Elementary and Harold C. Rapson Scholarship

**Description:** Lincoln Elementary Scholarships are being offered to former Lincoln School Students who have decided to continue their academic desires beyond K-12. - 6. The student will need two letters of recommendation: one from a current teacher; and the other from a person of a candidate's choice.
- 7. Please attach a current photo of yourself with your application.

**Final Selection:** All applications will be reviewed by a panel of staff members. The final recipients will be notified no later than **May 26, 2017.**
