

## 2017-2018 SCHEDULING INFORMATION FOR MHS CLASS OF 2021

On the reverse side of this sheet you will find an MHS Course Selection Sheet/Checklist to be used to select your classes at Monroe High School for the 2017-2018 school year.

### How this works:

- 1) WEEK OF FEBRUARY 13<sup>TH</sup>: Mrs. Hudson (Student Service Coordinator at MMS) makes classroom presentations on scheduling and hands out materials to 8<sup>th</sup> graders.
- 2) Students bring home materials and discuss scheduling information with parents/guardians.
- 3) Students will select **15 classes and 2 alternates** using the Course Selection Sheet on reverse side of this paper.
- 4) FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 24<sup>TH</sup>: Completed Course Selection Sheets due and handed in to students Social Studies Teacher
- 5) WEEK OF FEBRUARY 27<sup>TH</sup>: Mrs. Hudson will be going back into Social Studies classrooms and assisting students with inputting their selected courses into the computer.
- 6) Once courses are input into the computer, scheduling is complete for MMS students.
- 7) AUGUST, 2017: Students will receive information on their MHS schedule at the New Trojan Retreat held during summer for incoming 9<sup>th</sup> graders (info sent out by MHS at a later date)

### Other Information You Need To Know:

Students should have 15 classes checked total (including Core and Elective courses) and 2 classes marked with “A” (for alternate)

Alternate classes are classes that a student would take if one of their previous choices are not available.

Core Classes are classes that are required for graduation.
