MIFA has sponsored a three-week student exchange with Hofu City, Japan, Monroe's Sister City for 25 years. We are proud to have been exchanging students since 1992 and to provide this unique educational and cultural opportunity to the high school students of Monroe County. The City of Monroe and the Mayor's office have been active supporters of this program since its inception. We believe that a program like this is very important for high school students to have opportunities to understand other cultures while keeping great relationships with other countries.

The details of the program are as follows:

This year we will choose three to five students from Monroe County to send to Hofu, Japan. Those students will tentatively leave for Japan on July 11, 2019, and return on Aug 2, 2019. Attached is the schedule of application and interview deadlines. Mandatory attendance of students and their parents and/or guardian is required at three informational meetings. The student's financial responsibility will be approximately \$2,300.00 (cost of airline ticket) plus passport fees and miscellaneous gifts for host families. MIFA, in conjunction with corporate sponsors, will take care of the balance of the expense. During their stay in Hofu, students will live with two host families and participate in a variety of activities, including Japanese school visits, sight-seeing in Hofu and Hiroshima, Japanese tea ceremony, Kendo, Shuji (Japanese calligraphy), and much more. Students **do not** need to know how to speak Japanese.

I hope that you may know students who would be interested in and benefit from this crosscultural experience. We are beginning the application and selection process for 2019, and would like to make this fantastic opportunity available to as many students as possible. I would be very grateful if you would announce the details of our program to your students or put in a school newspaper and encourage them to apply.

Please make the included application available to interested students. Adult MIFA members who have accompanied past exchange students and several former exchange students themselves are available to give presentations to interested students in your school or organization.
